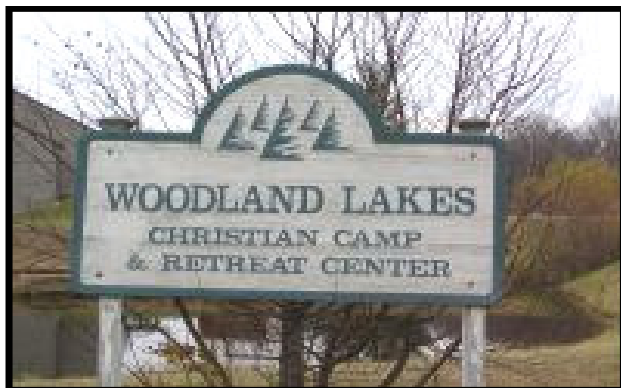

This year, we are looking forward to another great experience!

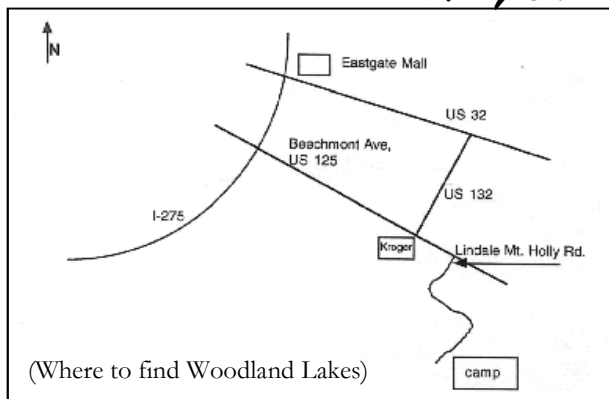
